The Scottish Public Pensions Agency (SPPA) have advised that they will issue Annual Benefit Statements for active members of the Police Pension Schemes (Scotland) by 31 August 2019, to your home address.

To qualify for an Annual Benefit Statement, you must have been an active Scheme member on 31 March 2019. If the SPPA have been unable to generate a statement, you will be issued a letter explaining why.

Your 2019 Annual Benefit Statement includes:

- Current Accrued Benefits
- Current level of death benefits
- Lifetime Allowance information
